Conch (pronounced 'konk') is a common name for certain large marine snails.They are gastropod mollusks, the most commercially important of which are in the family Strombidae. The specific species most commonly used for food is the queen conch, or pink-lipped conch, *Strombus gigas*, which can be found in warm waters of the Atlantic and the Caribbean from Florida to Brazil.
