You must be a current Film Independent Member to apply for fiscal sponsorship. The program is open to independent narrative and documentary projects of any length and at any stage of development.

Projects We Sponsor. To be considered for Fiscal Sponsorship projects must be consistent with the TFC's charitable purposes, be creative, artistic and/or educational, not a "work for hire" and represent an imaginative contribution to the film or video art form.

The Southern Documentary Fund offers fiscal sponsorship for documentary projects made in or about the American South. Having a fiscal sponsor allows artists to solicit funds from government agencies, foundations, trusts, individuals, and other philanthropic sources that require IRS nonprofit status in order to contribute to a project.

Fiscal Sponsorship does NOT imply that the Film Office funds any projects directly. What is the benefit of having a Fiscal Sponsor? Engaging a Fiscal Sponsor allows you to apply for foundation grants available only to non profits and to offer individual donors a tax deduction for their donation to your project.

Fiscal Sponsorship - Greater Philadelphia Film Office

AFS MAKE members can submit their projects for fiscal sponsorship. If approved, the filmmaker can use AFS's 501 (c)(3) status as an "umbrella" when applying to government granting agencies and foundations that will only grant funds to non-profit organizations. Fiscally sponsored projects can also solicit tax-deductible donations from private individuals and businesses.

Sponsored Films | Austin Film Society

The Film Center accepts fiscal sponsorship applications on a rolling basis. A project may be submitted for review at any time. Applicants are strongly encouraged to call prior to submitting an application to discuss the appropriateness of the project (non-commercial), potential funding sources, and production schedule.

Fiscal Sponsorship. Fiscal sponsorship allows filmmakers to solicit and receive tax deductible in support of a specific project, without having to create a 501 (c) (3) non-profit corporation. NB: Film Forum does not provide funding to filmmakers. More info. Donate to a fiscally sponsored film.

Fiscal Sponsorship - Utah Film Center

Fiscal Sponsorship is used when a non-profit film or film-related project or event wants to secure funding from individual, foundation, government or corporate sources that give only to nonprofit organizations with IRS tax-exempt status. To be considered exempt, an organization must hold a current 501(c)(3) certificate from the IRS.

IFP's Fiscal Sponsorship program focuses exclusively on documentary films and other works of nonfiction, short films and low-budget fiction/narrative features (50 minutes+). Many individuals, foundations, corporations, or government organizations restrict funding of independent projects to tax-exempt organizations.
